CORE MESSAGE

1. WALK TO THE GROUNDS
2. ARRIVE EARLY.
3. One way traffic system – Centre park rd down & Monaghan Rd up
4. ALL CITY CAR-PARKS OPEN + Cork Camogie Gds (500 spaces)
5. IRISH RAIL – extra carriages plus free parking (Midleton –Cork Rail line)
6. TOWING IN OPERATION

CITY CAR PARKS

All City Car parks are open

PARKING

Sat & Sun - Cork Camogie Grounds – Castle Road – 500 Spaces – via Castle Road and Marina .

RAIL – 400 passengers per train – free parking

Rail Capacity from **Midleton**, taking in stops at **Carrigtwohill**, **Little Island** and **Glounthaune** Stations will be doubled from two Carriages to Four Carriages for each train (from 200 to 400 passengers per train). He advises that there is FREE parking for **400 cars** at Midleton, **250 cars** at Carrigtwohill and approx 200 at each of the other locations.

Disabled Passes

Approx 200 issued by GAA nationally – parking in Link Road (Marquee site) Must have GAA issued pass. Must access by Victoria Roundabout / Centre park Rd.

No access to personal issued disability badges
