## **NOTES ON INTER-CLUB TRANSFER FORM**

The granting of a transfer at any level does not make a player legal, in the event of his not having declared certain information which could render him illegal.

A person who is under suspension is not eligible for transfer.

### All sections of this transfer form must be completed before the transfer can be processed by County C.C.C

### Notes on how to fill up the form: -

- 1. Enter the applicants full name in Irish, with the English form in the section opposite. (Block **Capitals Only**)
- 2. Enter the applicants new permanent address in Irish, with the English form in the section opposite.
- 3. Name the club in Tipperary from which the applicant wishes to transfer.
- 4. Name the club in Tipperary to which the applicant wishes to transfer.
- 5. Date of applicants last game with former club Grade of last game i.e., Senior, Intermediate, Junior etc.
- 6. Applicant must sign the Application Form in Irish and enter the date signed.
- 7. Have the form signed by the Secretary of club the applicant is transferring to.

Forward the completed form to the Secretary of the County CCC in Lar na Pairce for the transfer to be recorded and for the official issue date to commence.

- 8. The County CCC Secretary then forwards the form to the Club, from which the player is transferring to in order to seek the approval of his club.
- 9. Once both clubs have signed their approval, the county CCC will make the final approval

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- 10. The Clubs should note that they have only 10 days from the date of the issuing of the form to object to a transfer.
- 11. The opening date for transfers is the 1<sup>st</sup> of January and closes at 5.30pm on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday in January of the year of application, as per County Tipperary Bye Law: Number 7.2.3. Except where the player did not play the previous year"
- 12. A transfer can only be opposed on the grounds of illegality.
- 13. If a club feels it should oppose the transfer on the grounds of illegality, the reason should be stated here: -
